Apple Minth

Apples on apples

Seven interesting facts about this delicious fruit.

- 1. The crabapple is the only apple native to North America. The wild ancestor of the sweet apples you now know and love originated in the Tian Shen mountains in modern-day Kazakhstan.
- 2. In the United States, 2,500 varieties of apples are grown. Gala, Red Delicious, Granny Smith, McIntosh and Honey Crisp are some of the most popular varieties.
- 3. Apple trees take four to five years to produce their first fruit. Many apple trees live between 50 and 80 years. However, some varieties can live up to 100 years.
- 4. Apples are extremely nutritious. They're fat-, sodium- and cholester-ol-free. Apples are also an excellent

source of dietary fiber. As the saying goes, "An apple a day keeps the doctor away"!

- Washington is the nation's top apple-producing state. Other top-producing states include New York, Michigan, Pennsylvania, California and Virginia.
- 6. Apples float on water. This is because they're made up of 25 percent air. If an item is denser than water, it sinks; if it's less dense, it floats.
- 7. Apples are classified as pome fruits. Pome fruits consist of a central core containing multiple small seeds, which is enveloped by a tough membrane and surrounded by an edible layer of flesh.

 Pears, quinces, loquats and medlars are other examples of pome fruits.





October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month. Even though this disease has many causes, several factors can increase the risk of contracting it. Here's an overview of some of those risk factors.

- 1. **Previous conditions.** You're more vulnerable to developing breast cancer if abnormal cells have been detected in your breasts in the past or had previous abnormalities.
- **2. Age.** More than 80 per cent of cases occur in women over the age of 50.
- **3. Alcohol.** According to the World Health Organization (WHO), drinking one beer or one glass of wine per day is enough to increase your risk significantly.
- **4. Menstrual cycle.** Early menstruation and late menopause are linked to the possibility of developing the disease.
- 5. Family history. Your risk of getting the di-

sease is higher if your mother, sister or daughter has been diagnosed with breast cancer, especially if it was before menopause.

- Pregnancy complications. Your risk increases if you've never carried a pregnancy to full term or if you've been pregnant after the age of 30.
- **7. Body weight.** People who are obese have a higher statistical likelihood of getting breast cancer.
- **8. Taking hormones.** Undergoing hormone replacement therapy for more than five years is associated with the onset of this type of cancer.
- **9. Physical inactivity.** A sedentary lifestyle increases the likelihood of a breast cancer diagnosis.



Many people enjoy online shopping. The product selection is virtually endless, it's convenient, and store are open 24/7. Here are four tips to ensure you're shopping safely.

- 1. Learn how to spot a scam. Offers that sound too good to be true, websites that lack a professional design and requests for banking information when your cart is still empty are all red flags.
- 2. Confirm the company is legitimate. Poor quality websites and excessive popup ads may be an indication that the company is not legit. Learn more about how what to kook for at at https://www.wikihow.com/Know-if-an-Online-Business-or-Company-Is-Legitimate.
- 3. Read the return policies beforehand. Find out whether the company offers exchanges, returns or reimbursements and under what conditions. This will help you avoid unpleasant surprises if there's an issue with your purchase. A lack of clearly stated policies is a sign you should shop elsewhere.
- 4. Double-check before you pay. Make sure the website's URL begins with "https" and has a closed padlock or unbroken key icon beside it. Confirm the price of each item and the total cost (including taxes and shipping fees) before you enter your credit card information.

Finally, remember that you should never provide unnecessary personal details, such as your social insurance number, when shopping online.



Wait Times for Community Care

Despite the amount of attention paid to it over the years, the Department of Veterans Affairs still struggles with wait times for medical appointments. Wait time eligibility becomes crucial when a veteran seeks medical care through Community Care. With the wrong wait time, the veteran can be denied treatment out in the community. The calculation of wait times has to be exact, either 20 or 28 days depending on the type of care.

If you are a VA staffer in charge of making Community Care medical appointments for a veteran patient, which of the following options do you choose in setting the appointment for a patient and starting the wait time clock? The date the provider wants the patient to be seen ... the date the patient wants to be seen ... the date the care provider or the veteran makes a request for an appointment?

Only one of those is correct. The correct answer is that the starting date for calculating wait time is that moment when a care provider or veteran asks for an appointment. Unfortunately, in one location, staff was using a combination of methods for calculating wait times using their own unauthorized wait time calculator they created from an online app. It threw off the numbers by 12 days, making it look like veterans were not eligible for Community Care.

The ongoing mistake only came to light when a trainer used that same calculator in another facility. At the same time, a veteran had been denied Community Care because the inaccurate calculations indicated that he was not wait-time eligible and he was given a VA facility appointment instead. As a result, there was a congressional inquiry.

The Office of Inspector General for the VA stepped in and discovered a great big mess of confusion and inconsistency at both facilities due to staffers using a calculator that a member of staff had made.

If you want Community Care, you need VA approval first. To see if you qualify, read the fine print at www. va.gov/CommunityCare.

Wrapping up the End of the Year

These last few months of the year are the perfect time to review where we've been in 2023 and gather some ideas about how we might do things differently next year. Saving money is at the top of many to-do lists now, especially for entertainment and groceries.

Look at all your streaming services to see which ones you might be willing to stop using. Make calls to the cellphone services around you and see who has good deals, likely with bundling. Phone plans for seniors generally have a lower cost. A surprise for me: I recently changed cellphone companies. Since I was bringing my own phone number and did not want a deal to buy a phone, I was given a \$200 promo gift card to spend anywhere.

At my local grocery store, I typically accrue \$5-10 per quarter just for buying the store brand and using the coupons offered. Consider the money you could save with a store membership or VIP card. On Walmart Plus, I often earn \$3-\$4 each time I place online orders for free delivery to my home because of the deals and discounts that pop up on the screen. Additional Plus benefits include travel, video streaming, 10 cents per gallon saved at several gas stations and more. The first 30 days are free to try the service, with a whole year costing \$98. If you're on SNAP, Medicaid or other programs, your cost would be half that.

Take a look at "500 Great Ways to Save for Dummies" by AARP. The book is on Amazon, both in paperback and for a Kindle e-reader, as well as thousands of other places online. This book might be one you want to keep for a long time. You can also ask your library or senior center if they will purchase the book to keep on the shelves.

How to Best Utilize Compression Stockings

DEAR DR. ROACH: Would you please address how to use compression socks? I sit most of the day, so wearing the socks helps my legs to feel less heavy and tired by the end of the day. Are there people who should not wear them? And what about wearing them during exercise? -- C.S.

ANSWER: Compression stockings are most commonly used for people with chronic venous insufficiency, a common condition in middle-aged to older people. The major symptom is swelling in the feet and lower legs. The swelling is usually minimal or gone in the morning and gets worse during the day, especially with prolonged standing and even sitting.

The underlying problem is that the veins, which carry blood from the legs back to the heart, get leaky over decades, and the fluid accumulates in the legs under the force of gravity. Your doctor can prescribe the right size, length and strength of stocking based on your personal condition.

The fact that you feel better with compression stockings suggests that you might have venous insufficiency, but it's still a good idea to ask your doctor about them. Compression stockings are pretty safe, but should not be worn by people with serious reduction in arterial blood flow to the legs.

Arterial disease is completely different from venous insufficiency. It's

caused by blockages in the arteries that carry blood from the heart to the legs. An expert, such as a vascular surgeon, is an appropriate consultant for a person with arterial insufficiency before they consider using compression stockings.

Unless you have moderate to severe arterial disease (in which case you should check with your doctor if you aren't sure), there is no harm from wearing compression stockings during exercise. There may even be some benefit.

Compression stockings should not be worn by those with an acute clot in a major leg vein (a deep venous thrombosis). Once the clot is stabilized for a few days with medication, compression stockings can help treat and even prevent swelling in the affected leg.

People with moderate to severe heart failure should exercise care before using compression stockings, which put the leaked-out fluid back into the circulation and can worsen heart failure. Again, this is an issue to discuss with your regular doctor or cardiologist prior to using compression stockings on your own.

Finally, severe venous insufficiency can cause breakdown in the skin. A person with ulcers or open wounds, or with any kind of acute infection, should be evaluated and treated prior to using compression stockings. A wound care nurse is an ideal consultant in this case.


Another way to reduce your symptoms is by taking allergy medication. Consult an allergist, doctor or pharmacist to determine the right treatment.

RECIPE from Stiletto Momma

Gluten Free Coconut Bread

INGREDIENTS:

2-¼ cups gluten free flour blend (If your flour blend does not have some tapioca starch in it, use 2 cups and ¼ cup tapioca starch — we like the texture)

1½ teaspoon xanthan gum or gum-free baking binder if your flour blend does not already contain it

1½ teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon baking powder

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

34 cup coconut oil

1½ cups sugar

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

3 large eggs

²/₃ cup coconut milk

5 oz sweetened flaked coconut

nonstick cooking spray (or a bit more coconut oil or butter for baking dish)



Preheat oven to 350°.

Grease two loaf pans.

Combine gluten free flour blend, xanthan gum or binder (if needed), salt, baking powder, and cinnamon in a bowl and set aside.

Put coconut oil or butter into a large mixing bowl, and slowly mix in sugar and vanilla until smooth and well blended. Add eggs one at a time, beating after each addition.

Add milk, mix for 2 minutes. Add dry ingredients in two or three steps, mixing well after each addition. Stir in coconut by hand or on lowest setting. Mix thoroughly. Divide batter into two loaf pans.

Bake for 55-60 minutes. A toothpick inserted near the middle should come out with just a crumb or two. Remove from oven, rest for about 10 minutes, then turn out onto a rack to cool completely.





Check-engine light on?

Here's what it really means


It can be nerve-racking to see the checkengine light flick onto your dashboard. However, it's important that you remain calm. Here's what you should know.

What it indicates

The check-engine light connects to your vehicle's diagnostic system, which is an onboard computer that monitors vehicle performance and automatically repairs issues. If it encounters a problem it's unable to fix, the diagnostic system turns on the engine-shaped orange or yellow light. This indicates that you need to get your car professionally serviced.

What you should do

If your check-engine light comes on, there's no need to panic or call a tow truck. It rarely signals an urgent problem such as a complete engine failure. Rather, in most cases, the checkengine light is merely warning you of an impending issue.

5 tips for avoiding driving-related pain

1. Adjust your seat

How to tell if your seat is properly positioned?

- You can press down on the pedals using your entire foot, heel to toe
- Your elbows are slightly bent when you grip the steering wheel
- There's 1-2 inches of space between the back of your knees and the front of your seat
- Your thighs and back are fully supported by the seat and backrest

If you find you need more lumbar support, place a cush-ion behind the small of your back.

2. Relax your posture

Sit comfortably against the backrest and place your hands on the steering wheel at the nine and three o'clock positions. Avoid leaning your head forward. If you're forced to lean forward, it means your seat is excessively reclined and needs to be adjusted.

3. Take regular breaks

If you're going on a long drive, stop every couple of hours to walk around and stretch. This will ease sore muscles and promote blood circulation. You can also move your arms, wrists and neck when waiting at a red light.

4. Check the air flow

To promote blood circulation when driving, direct heat to your upper body rather than to your legs. Conversely, in summer, direct the air conditioning toward your legs.

5. Empty your pockets

If you have bulky items in your pockets, they can hinder movement in your pelvis or impede circulation in your legs. Before you get behind the wheel, remove your wallet, smartphone and other objects from your pockets.

Adopt these good habits and you should feel more alert at the wheel and be free of pain when you reach your destination.

gift tax on the gifted amount. However, you can gift someone up to \$17,000 before paying this tax. Keep in mind that you'll be taxed for withdrawing money from a 401(k) or IRA.







A fire extinguisher is a vital safety device that can help suppress small fires before they escalate into dangerous blazes. Brush up on your fire preparedness knowledge with this brief guide to fire extinguishers.

Firstly, it's important to familiarize yourself with the different types of fire extinguishers and their suitable applications:

- Class A fire extinguishers are suitable for ordinary combustibles like wood and paper
- Class B extinguishers are suitable for flammable liquids and gases
- Class C extinguishers are intended for use on fires involving appliances, motors and tools
- Class D extinguishers are designed for use on combustible metals
- Class K extinguishers are suitable for kitchen fires

You can also find multipurpose fire extinguishers that are suitable for more than one class, like A-B, B-C or A-B-C.

Fire extinguishers must be kept in prominent, easily accessible locations like mounted to a wall. Ideally, you should have a portable fire extinguisher on every floor of your home, especially near potential fire hazards like kitchens, garages and workshops.

The PASS technique

In the event of a fire, remember the PASS acronym:

Pull the pin. Hold the extinguisher upright and pull the pin to break the tamper seal.

Aim low. Point the nozzle or hose at the base of the fire.

Squeeze the lever. Firmly squeeze the lever to discharge the extinguishing agent.

Sweep side to side. Sweep the nozzle or hose from side to side, covering the base of the fire until it's completely extinguished.

By understanding how to properly use and store a fire extinguisher, you can enhance fire safety in your home.




